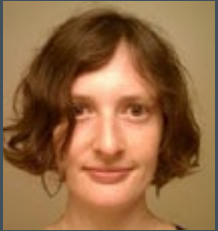


KEITH SANDERS, Chief Engineer Kansas City Area Transportation Authority

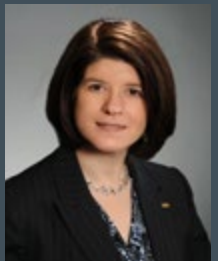


LAURA MACHALA, Planner Mid -America Regional Council

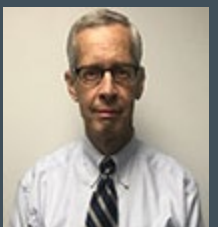


DAWN T. WARRICK, Planning Director City of Tulsa
