Required Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled junior or senior undergraduate student, or graduate student in planning, geography/GIS, public policy, landscape architecture, environmental studies/sciences, political science, or related fields. May accept recent graduates within one year of completing their program of study.
- Strong interest in pursuing urban, regional, or transportation planning as a career
- Proven time management skills and work ethic
- Proven professional communication skills
- Willingness to work in different environments, both indoors and outdoors, as necessary
- Ability to attend work in person at the NWARPC office in Springdale, Arkansas

- Provide administrative support for and attend commission and committee meetings
- Assist with local government planning support such as drafting code, drafting ordinance, and public hearing notifications
- Assist in the preparation of charts, graphs, and maps using current technology
